

## Modern Slavery Act Statement

We, therefore, may terminate our relationship with any contractors, or other organisations working on our behalf if they fail to comply with any applicable anti-slavery and human trafficking laws, statutes, regulations and codes from time to time in force including the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
